Year 6 Residential trip to Robin Wood Activity Centre Marchwiel Nr. Wrexham

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to announce that the Year 6 Residential Trip will be taking place on the 9th – 11th September 2020 at the recently opened Maes-y-Nant Activity Centre. It is set in the beautiful Welsh countryside based just outside Wrexham. The centre offers a range of exciting opportunities for the children including:

- Raft Building and Canoeing on a purpose built lake; shallow enough to be perfect for Key Stage 2 pupils and big enough for a real feel of adventure.
- Giant Swing and a Zip wire of around 80 metres in length, perfect for Key Stage 2 adventurers.
- The legendary Piranha Pool, Dungeon and Quest themed problem solving sessions.
- Purpose built, brand new buildings, house Archery and a specially designed indoor Caving system, which allows these activities to take place all year round.

Parents are invited to come and join us on **Tuesday 12th November at 2.30pm in the KS2 Hall**, where I will lead an information session and share details of the visit. You will also have the opportunity to find out more information and ask any questions. If you are unable to attend the meeting, the PowerPoint will be available to view on the school website.

The cost of the trip will be **£255** per child which includes the coach cost. Places for 2020 are **limited to 65 and will allocated on a first come, first served basis**. A **deposit of £40 will be needed to secure your place no later than Monday 18th November**. The cost will be spread across a manageable payment plan. Pupils who are presently registered or have been previously registered for Free School Meals in the last six years are subsidised and the total cost is reduced by 50%. Please note that the Universal Free School Meal Initiative (the free school meal received in KS1) is not part of Pupil Premium funding.
